Selection and activities

Selection of n. 19 candidates:

- n. 10 from Molise Region;
- n. 1 from Molise Region belongs to disadvantage categories;
- n. 4 from Albania;
- n. 4 from Montenegro.

The activities of the Targeted training consist in classroom lessons and groupworks.

Lessons are held in English.

The duration is 30 hours (5 days).

The Targeted training is addressed to provide adequate know-how to understand the changing needs of the tourism market and develop new forms of tourism including Workation in rural areas. In particular, the Targeted training will focus on "Workation in rural areas and financial opportunities sustaining enterprise creation in tourism sector".

At the end of the training, the participants produce the reports of the activities, take a test to evaluate the acquired skills and complete a satisfaction questionnaire about the attended targeted training.
